

## Burghley Pony Club Day Camp 2018

Hello Everyone

Day Camp is open to all members who are either not old enough or do not feel ready to go to Resi Camp.

It will run from Monday 30th July to Thursday 2nd August inclusive in Burghley Park.

The cost of attending camp is £100, which is very good value for all the excellent instruction and fun activities over the camp period.

Please would parents of all members wanting to attend camp complete the Rally Form Online and send the £50.00 deposit via paypal by 31 May 2018 at the latest. We will endeavour to get everyone in who wants to come however places may be limited. Please include any medical conditions and allergies in the additional information section of the rally form.

We will be doing camp hoodies again this year. They will have Burghley Pony Club printed on the back along with the member's name or nickname and have camp '18 printed down one arm. Whilst the children cannot ride in the hoodies at pony club ( health and safety!) they are great for some of the other times when not on the ponies and a firm wardrobe favourite for the rest of the year. I will send details of how to order these to members once your place is confirmed.

For those of you who are new to camp here is an outline of how it all works:

Day camp is for our younger members and those who don't feel ready for Residential camp. This year it will run from 10am to 4pm Mon - Thurs. Members are grouped into rides of their age and ability which will be under the leadership of an experienced instructor. They will have mounted instruction in the morning and afternoon and also some stable management lessons and other activities. On Thursday afternoon parents, friends and family are invited to watch the ride sessions and there will be an end of camp parade and presentations.

Ponies and members come to camp on a daily basis, we do not have any facilities for the ponies to stay over. Children need to bring a picnic lunch each day and we provide cold drinks & biscuits/cakes during the morning and afternoon and a tuck shop is open after lunch. Members will be assigned helpers (an older Burghley PC member) for the duration of camp. Parents are not required to stay during the day, however there will be some help needed from parents of all members attending at some time before or during camp, for example, setting up or putting away equipment, providing cakes /biscuits etc.

More detailed instructions and equipment lists will be sent out to those attending nearer the time.
