

HUNTER TRIAL VACCINE RULES

Following the BEF guide lines on equine influenza all horses attending these hunter trials must be vaccinated as below.

Any horses without passports and compliant vaccination records will be asked to leave the site, along with any others which they may have travelled with.

Boosters given within seven days of the Event is fine. As long as the vaccination was given at least the day before the horse arrives at the Event, and is not more than one year after the previous booster.

Horses must of had two injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart. Only these two injections need to have been given before a horse/pony can attend. In addition, if sufficient time has elapsed a 3rd injection must of been given no less than 150 days and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently a booster injection must of been given no later than 12 months after the date of the 3rd injection
